Statement of Purpose

The mission of the Valley Christian Schools is printed on the back of this application. Please take a moment to read it before you sign the application. It is our desire to be partners in the education of young people and it is important that we are united in mission and values.

Valley Christian School's role in cooperation with the home and church is to provide a Christ-centered education. It is our desire to promote a strong relationship between the family, church and school. The following are expectations which we have of all families:

- To have an active church life, including weekly church attendance
- To work together with the school to provide Christian nurture and to maintain Biblical standards, policies, and procedures
- To support the school in prayer and be active in school affairs and functions
- To faithfully meet all financial obligations to the school

All children whose parents or guardians demonstrate by word and practice that they are Christians, hold a belief in the Bible as the infallible Word of God, and are members of a church which proclaims Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are eligible for enrollment.

Because we believe that all children are created in the image of God and are placed on earth to serve God and our fellow man, we do not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, or national origin.

All students that are accepted are placed on probation for one semester. The probation is based on church, academic and behavioral issues. At the end of this period, the student's status is reviewed before recommendation is made for continuation in the school.

Any changes which may occur during the school year with respect to family status, church affiliation, or student behavior at school may be cause for the reevaluation of this application by the Admissions Committee.

Prior to Admission Interview

In order to be interviewed for admission, the following must be received at: VCS Business Office 10818 E. Artesia Blvd, Cerritos 90703.

- Completed application form.
- A one-time application fee of \$395 per family is charged to those enrolling a student in grades K–12. The \$395 fee is non-refundable, unless your family is not interviewed.
- A \$200 enrollment fee is due at the time of application for preschool families. Fee is non-refundable.
- Copy of the student's school transcript (for high school applicants) or last report card (for elementary and middle school applicants).
- Pastor's Letter of Recommendation, completed and signed by the pastor and returned directly to VCS.
- Student Information Form, completed by your child's previous school and returned directly to VCS.
- Doctrinal Basis statement signed and returned directly to VCS.
- Bring a copy of your child's immunization record (including TB test) to the interview.
- Preschool and Elementary Families: bring your child's original birth certificate. A copy will be made at VCS.
