Supplies and Items to Bring to Preschool

Please **bring these items** to the preschool during the week of **August 30th – Sept. 3rd**. This allows the teachers to have your child's cubby ready and items in containers – thus allowing the first day of school to be unhurried and a smooth transition for everyone. We appreciate your support.

Every Child Will Need:

- A crib sized sheet & blanket with your child's name and last initial. (Even part-time children will bring these in the event of illness or the need for us to provide a full day/nap for your child)
- A clear plastic shoebox with lid containing a complete change of clothing. (socks, undies, shirt, pants)
- An Earthquake Disaster Kit. (see attached list)

Please do not bring toys or books until *Share Day* is announced

Earthquake/ Disaster Kit

In the event of an emergency that warrants a child staying at school overnight, we as a school need to be prepared to provide a ration of food and liquids to your child.

The school has a supply of bottled water and food items that will provide nourishment for several days, if needed. The kit you are preparing is a supplement to the supplies that we have stored.

Please use a large zip-lock freezer bag and fill it with any of these suggestions:

Food Suggestions

Protein items-ie: Beef jerky, vienna sausage, nuts, tuna, protein bars, trail mix

Bottled waters

Juice boxes

Granola bars

Boxed raisins

Pretzels

Canned Fruit, applesauce

Spoon, napkin

A solar blanket- may be purchased at a sporting goods store

Family Photo- Please include a written note to comfort your child
