VCHS would like to remind and inform students and parents how we, as Christ's followers, should represent ourselves at such an event. VCHS is committed to working diligently in partnership with parents to educate students and believes that these types of social experiences are an important part of education. You can help us make this night one of the highlights of your student's high school years.

Parents and students must agree to, sign, and turn in this form at the time of ticket purchase.

Appropriate Attire:

Here are the dress code guidelines for males and females. **Any student that does not comply with these guidelines will be asked to alter their attire at the door or will not be admitted into the dance.** Please note that signing this form acknowledges that you will abide by the dress code below and understand the consequences of arriving to the dance out of dress code.

Gentlemen	Ladies
Shirt and tie, sport coat, suit, or tuxedo. No tennis shoes, flip flops, jeans, shorts, baseball hats.	Elegant evening gown or dress. The length must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. No exposed midriff or excessively low necklines including mesh, see-through, cutouts, or peek-a-boo style dresses, or excessively tight or short styles. No 2-piece dresses. No slits higher than mid-thigh. No open backs should fall below the natural waist.

Conduct:

As Christians we are called to be in this world, not of this world. We expect students to be respectful and appropriate on and off the dance floor. Overly suggestive dancing will not be tolerated and students will be asked to leave if they fail to respond appropriately.

I understand that students at school-sponsored events are not allowed to be either in possession of or under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance. I agree to provide transportation home for my son/daughter if a representative of Valley Christian High School determines that my son/daughter is in possession of or under the influence of a controlled substance. Additionally, I understand that my son/daughter will be suspended from school, for an indefinite period of time, pending action by the Board of Directors on a motion for expulsion.

I also agree that no alcoholic beverages will be served to students in my home before or after the event and that transportation services used by my son/daughter will be notified that the patrons are under age and may not consume or be served alcohol or any other controlled substance.

Breaking any of the above will result in a phone call home, removal from the dance, and further discipline as appropriate.
