






Expectations

- iPad is primarily used as an educational tool!
 - Students must have iPad each day
 - Loaners are available for \$3.00 and an tardy will be issued (no tardy if students comes before 8:15am or at break)
 - iPads must be fully charged at the start of the day
 - Chargers are available for \$1.00 per day and an tardy will be issued (no tardy if students comes before 8:15am or at break)

Cases

No specific brand of case is required, BUT be sure it matches the iPad model/generation.

We recommend:

- significant protection for all 4 corners
- one that is not prone to opening by accident





Managed Apple ID's

- Non-commerce (can't download/buy from App Store)
- 200 GB of free iCloud storage!

STUDENT APPLE ID: username##@vcschools.org

(same as their school email address)

PASSWORD: PowerSchool Password

Students should not use any other AppleID on their school iPad.

Apps

- School Apps: Will either be automatically installed or are available for students to install from the Manager app.
- Non-School Related Apps: Parents can install through a PowerSchool parent account.
 - Look for Student iPad link on left

Content Filtering/Monitoring

All internet access on your student's iPad passes through our content filter, even off campus!

Securly Parent App - You will receive an invitation via email. You can control categories, specific websites, even pause the Internet.

Apple Classroom: Teachers can monitor student iPads while they teach.



Apple Classroom

Our teachers can monitor what the students in their class are doing — every student iPad shows up along with an icon indicating what app is being used.





Automatic Restrictions

- We have put restrictions on the iPad.
- Non-school apps (eg. Messages & FaceTime) will disappear from the iPads when school starts and will reappear after school.
- If you have any additional needs in the area of parental controls, please contact us.

Parent Tools

Canvas - Learning Management System (LMS) the "online" classroom

PowerSchool - Grades, Attendance, Forms, etc.

- AppleTree
 - PowerSchool Parent account Student iPad
 - Can install non-school related apps (and remove Messages & FaceTime)

Securly Filter

- A parent app you can use on your mobile phone. You can monitor and restrict/allow categories and individual websites. You'll get a weekly report in your email.
- Look for an email from the school with instructions to create your account.
