

## **HS Band Director**

Valley Christian High School is seeking a part-time Band Director for the 2023-2024 school year. The Band Director is responsible to teach and instruct members of the Wind Ensemble and Pep Band in music education, helping students develop their musical literacy on a specific instrument. (S)He plans a balanced music program that utilizes varied avenues of instruction and learning to keep students engaged. (S)He also collaborates with other music faculty to provide multiple performance opportunities for students to showcase their skills for their peers and parents. (S)He serves as a Christian role model who promotes a student culture of a love for Christ, and a love for music.

At VCHS, our students come to school with a wide array of abilities, interests, and backgrounds. It is the job of our faculty to engage each individual student and develop a relationship that not only supports learning but provides mentorship and wisdom on the journey to adulthood.

### **Responsibilities**

- Creates lesson plans and picks a mix of traditional and contemporary music that is appropriate for the ages and demonstrated skill level of performers.
- Evaluates, assesses, and supports individual student and full band development and performance.
- Collaborates with faculty & staff to provide multiple performance opportunities for students to showcase their skills for their peers and parents.
- Instructs and directs band at all performances.
- Maintains accurate inventory over school-owned instruments, music, uniforms, and equipment to prevent loss and to assess for repair and replacement.
- Selects and requisitions appropriate music, books, instruments, and instructional aids, to enhance student learning.
- Serves as a Christian role model for all music program students demonstrating Christ-like character in all situations.
- May act as an instructor for beginning players in elementary and/or middle school.

### **Qualifications**

- Experience teaching or instructing music (preferably in a school setting).
- A bachelor's degree is required. BA/BS in a related field (e.g. Music, Education, etc.) is preferred.
- Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Active membership/attendance at a Protestant Christian church is required.
- Supports the Mission and Doctrinal Statement of Valley Christian Schools
