 - Discuss some of the main character's/s' actions that show the author's message.
 - Please be sure to put your name, the title of the book and the author on top.

This needs to be completed by the first Friday of the school year.

Returning 10th – 12th grade: You will need to run this through the Summer Reading Turnitin Canvas assignment the first week of school in order to receive credit.
